RESOLUTION ON RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR PERSONS DISABLED OR SIXTY-FIVE OR OLDER

The resolution set out below was introduced for consideration of the Board. It was duly moved and seconded that said resolution be adopted; and after due discussion, said motion carried by the following vote:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of PRESTONWOOD FOREST UTILITY DISTRICT, hereinafter called "District" as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of Article 8, Section 1-b(b) of the Constitution of the State of Texas, this Board has authority to exempt certain values of each residence homestead within the District of a person disabled or 65 years of age or older from all ad valorem taxes hereafter levied by District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District has considered this matter in detail in connection with the financial needs of the District.

Based on the aforesaid study, the Board of Directors has considered the exemption of taxable property for those persons resident within the District disabled or 65 years of age and over and hereby establishes a homestead exemption for residents of the District disabled or 65 years of age and over in the amount of \$100,000.00, said exemption to remain in effect from year to year until revoked or otherwise modified by the Board.
